Wakefield Cathedral Choir is nationally and internationally acclaimed as one of the best in England. Choristers develop musical skills together with a high degree of professionalism, becoming notable high-achievers in later life. The normal pattern of rehearsals and services requires Girl Choristers to be present at the Cathedral on Wednesdays from 5.15 pm to 6.40 pm, Fridays from 6.00 pm to 7.20 pm, and on Sundays from 8.50 am to 10.30 am. There are a number of additional commitments as one would expect in a Cathedral; yet Choristers still find time for numerous and varied other activities.

Each term, the girls receive a pleasing sum of pocket money from the Cathedral, in return for their hard work. Choristers who attend Wakefield Girls' High School also receive a small fee remission. There are opportunities to take part in television and radio programmes, CD recordings, and to go on tours both abroad and in this country.

Membership of the Cathedral Choir brings many rewards: knowledge of music and skill in singing, good teamwork, high self-confidence, and a notable ability to manage time.
