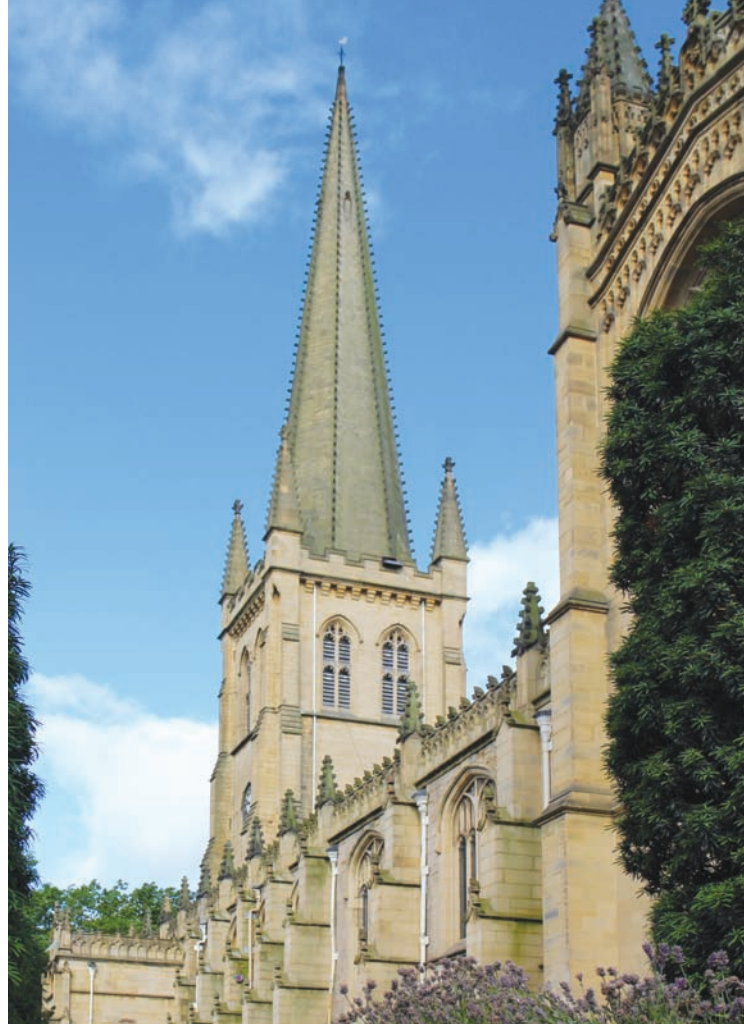
## People
