Water into Wine

1 Corinthians 12 1-11 John 2 1-11

On the third day a wedding took place at Cana in Galilee. Jesus' mother was there, and Jesus and his disciples had also been invited to the wedding. When the wine was gone, Jesus' mother said to him, "They have no more wine." **John 2 1-3** (New International Version)

In today's gospel reading, St John tells us about the first miracle performed by Jesus. This isn't a miracle where Jesus heals someone, in fact it may seem like a very odd miracle for Jesus to have done. Mary, Jesus and the disciples were at a wedding. During the feast the wine ran out. Mary tells Jesus about the wine. At first Jesus seems unsure whether he should help but Mary tells the servants to do whatever Jesus asks them to. Jesus tells them to fill six stone jars full of water and then to take some of that water to the master of the feast. When the servants did this the master was astonished at how good this new wine was. The disciples saw this miracle as proof that Jesus was God's son.

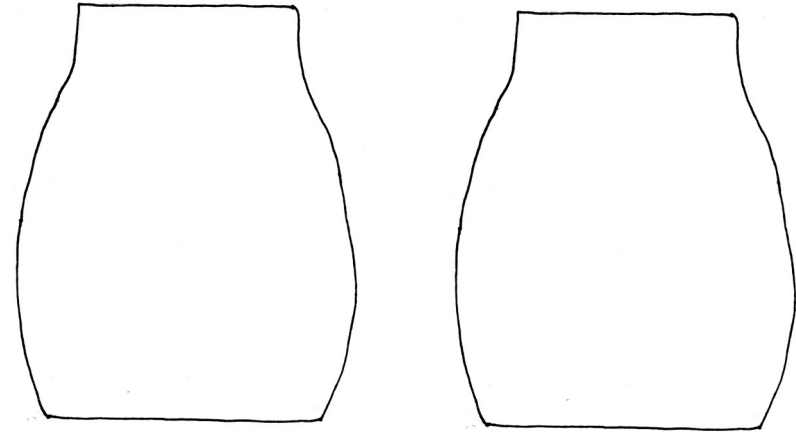
Today's Activities:
