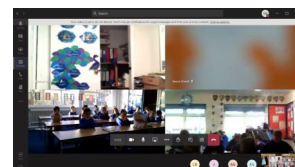

School Age Children

Flanshaw J & I School

Over the past three years I have regularly lead collective worship for the KS2 children at Flanshaw School. This was the first time I had done it on-line. Their theme for this half term is Friendship. As it had recently been All Saints' Day, our patronal feast, I decided to tell them about St Oswald and St Aiden. These saints are both depicted in the windows of Wakefield Cathedral.



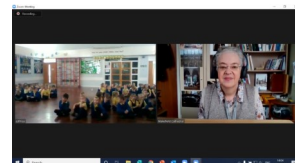
Wakefield Girls' High School

Although WGHS have been regular visitors to Wakefield Cathedral over the past three years this was the first virtual visit they had requested from me for their Y5 classes. They chose a workshop focussing on the cathedral as a Christian place of worship. Using powerpoint picture they were able to look at different parts of the cathedral and learn how they are used in worship. They also looked at different Christian symbols and how they relate to aspects of worship such as prayer, eucharist and baptism. As an activity, they wrote prayers which some of them shared. They also watched a short film showing our labyrinth being used.



Normanton All Saints C of E VA Infants School

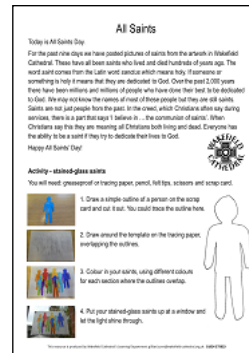
Whilst the Y2 classes from Normanton All Saints had visited the cathedral before, this was the first time I had been in contact with the FS2 classes. They requested a bespoke virtual visit focussing on baptism. I showed them pictures of the cathedral and the stained glass. Through our stained glass window that shows Jesus being baptised by John, I was able to introduce the theme of baptism. We then looked at pictures of the font and acted out a baptism service.

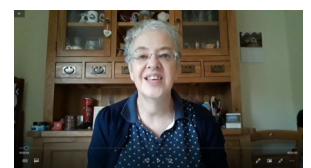
