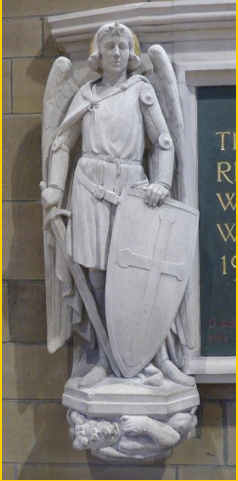

Your Task:

Make a dragon puppet

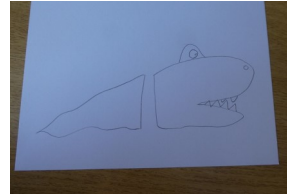
What you will need:

White card, a sheet of any coloured paper, felt tip pens or colouring pencils, scissors, glue, sticky tape and two lolly sticks.

If you don't have any coloured paper you could use white paper and colour it in with the felt tips or colouring pencils.



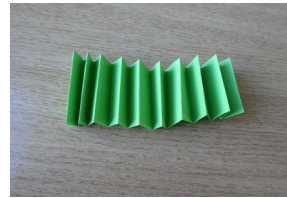
The Activity:



1. On the cardboard draw a dragon's head and tail.



2. Colour them in and cut out.



3. Cut a strip of coloured paper about the same width as the head and tail, fold the paper in a concertina.



4. Glue the head to one end and the tail to the other of the concertina strip.



5. Tape the lolly sticks to the back of the head and tail.
