This music list takes us through one of the most interesting parts of the Christian year – liturgically as well as musically. Ash Wednesday marks the start of Lent, when the singing of the Litany in procession forms once again part of the Sunday 11:00 Choral Eucharist, and the music during this season becomes reflective and helps to draw us deeper into journeying with Christ towards the events of Good Friday. Yet there are times of joy too: we celebrate the installation of our Dean on Saturday 07 March, which marks the start of a new phase in the life of the cathedral; and there is an opportunity for local singers to come and sing Stainer's 'Crucifixion' on Passion Sunday, 22 March. We also mark the Feast of the Annunciation with a Choral Eucharist on 25 March. Holy Week follows, with a range of beautiful and meditative music as we follow the events of Christ's last week on earth, before the Easter festivities. Do come and join us for any or all of our services during this period: you'll be most welcome.
