Your Task:

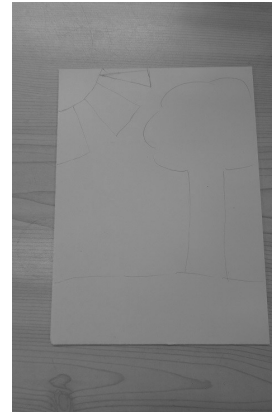
Make a seed picture

The Activity:



1. Draw a simple picture or pattern on the card.



2. Carefully spread plenty of glue over a section of the picture and stick the seeds on.



3. Continue gluing other sections and sticking the seeds on, leave your picture flat to dry.
