Is That Fair?

The story in today's gospel takes place in a vineyard where grapes are grown. Grapes were a very important fruit in Jesus's time because they were used to make wine. In those days water was often too dirty to drink so drinking wine was actually a safer option. There are lots of references to grape vines and vineyards in the bible. As well as telling parables set in vineyards Jesus also said, 'I am the vine; you are the branches. If you remain in me and I in you, you will bear much fruit.'

Your Task:

Grape vine printing

What you will need:

Bubble wrap, scissors, scrap card, glue, paper, paint and paint brushes.

The Activity:



1. Carefully cut out a triangle from the bubble wrap.



2. Glue the bubble wrap triangle onto the card with the bubble side upwards.



3. Cover the bubble wrap in paint.



4. Print the grapes onto the paper.



5. Paint in the stem and leaves.
